ESP organises the European Congress of Pathology (ECP) annually, holds several virtual and on-site postgraduate courses each year, among others through the European School of Pathology, ESP Academy, Masterclasses, and has an official journal "Virchows Archiv".


CMF Credits

Professional Spectrum of ECP Delegates







Booking & Allocation Process

Application Forms

Bookings for ECP 2025 are made using the respective application forms. Please ensure the forms are fully completed and signed before sending them to the provided email address (see application forms). The ESP Team will review the application and confirm the booking as soon as possible.

Allocation

Bookings for ECP 2025 sponsoring and exhibition services will open on October 2024. All bookings will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis, prioritised by the respective sponsorship level (see page 14 for details).

Important: All bookings via the registration forms are legally binding. Companies must accept Appendix 1 - ECP Industry Guidelines and Appendix 2 - ECP Terms and Conditions as well as the Privacy Policy during the booking process.

Some services require further allocation after booking (e.g. allocation of exhibition space, advertising options, allocation of a specific symposium slot/preferred day/placement). For these, our ranking rules apply if preferences overlap with those of other sponsors.

In order to ensure transparency, order and fairness for all sponsors, the following ranking rules apply to the allocation within the same sponsorship level and to all bookings received before the respective booking deadline for the ranking of the corresponding sponsorship level.

1st criterion Total amount of the financial contribution for ECP 2025.

2nd criterion If two or more sponsors make the same financial contribution, the date and time of the booking will be used as the criterion for the ranking.

The ESP Team, along with the Scientific Committee, will make every effort to accommodate the requests of sponsors and exhibitors when assigning the respective services.

The booth and symposium slot allocation will start after the 2 April 2025 deadline.

The main objective of Industry Sponsored Symposia organised by pharmaceutical and medical device companies is the dissemination of scientific data and innovations. Thus, these symposia will enhance the congress experience for all participants.

The sponsor shall organise its symposium independently, after consulting with the ECP 2025 Organisers. If desired, the ESP will be happy to assist with selecting a topic and speakers. The ECP 2025 Scientific Committee will strive to ensure there is no thematic overlap with parallel symposia at the time the symposium is held.

Furthermore, the organiser of each Industry Sponsored Symposium must ensure that the messages and conclusions presented are based on solid scientific data. The sponsor must inform the chairperson(s) of this responsibility. Titles and speakers' names will be included in the final programme, on the congress website, and in the congress app after approval by the ESP.

Time slots will be allocated primarily according to the sponsorship level. Industry symposia will be running in parallel with other industry symposia. The programme of an industry symposium is not affiliated with ESP and the responsibility for the content remains with the company.

The price includes the following benefits:

- Provision of a room
- Supply of basic technical equipment in the room
- Publishing of meeting programme and inclusion of sponsor's name in the final congress programme, on the congress website and in the congress app

- Sponsors may set up 1 roll-up-banner for their symposium at the Congress Venue on the day prior
 to the symposium and take it down after the symposium (production and set-up at sponsor's own
 discretion and expense).
- Sponsors may publish their own programme, abstracts and proceedings themselves.

The price does not include travel costs, hotel accommodation and congress registration for speakers/chairs of an industry symposium. Speakers/chairs must be registered for ECP 2025. The registration fee is EUR 250,00 per speaker for the day of the symposium, also if speakers are part of the scientific programme.

Very important: all faculty need to be on-site to hold their presentations, there is no virtual participation possible which feed into the live symposium.

Please note that neither catering nor beverages are included in the booking of an industry symposium. For Luncheon Satellite Symposium organisers we highly recommend to consider the provision of lunch. Please arrange this directly with our official catering partner.
